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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Goldwind Background

1.2 The Requirement

FE Overberg Phase 2 invites suitably qualified and experienced service providers to submit quotations for the provision of Temporary Electrical Installation Inspection Services. The appointed service provider will be responsible for conducting regular inspections of all temporary electrical installations on the project and ensuring compliance with applicable South African legal and safety requirements.

B-BBEE Requirement: Priority be given to:

- Enterprises that are at least **51% Black-owned**
- **B-BBEE Level 1** contributors

1.3. Scope of Services:

The service provider shall provide temporary electrical installation inspection services for the FE Overberg Phase 2 Project, including the following:

- Conducting four (4) weekly inspections per month of all temporary electrical installations on site.
 - Verifying compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA), Construction Regulations 2014 (CR 24), Electrical Installation Regulations 2009, and applicable SANS standards.
 - Inspecting temporary distribution boards, cables, extension leads, plugs, sockets, generators, earth leakage protection devices, and earthing arrangements.
 - Identifying unsafe conditions, defects, and non-compliant electrical installations.
 - Issuing detailed weekly inspection reports with findings, photographs, and corrective action recommendations.
 - Submitting a monthly compliance summary report consolidating all weekly inspections.
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- Maintaining inspection records for audit and compliance purposes.
- Providing technical support during client, HSE, and regulatory audits relating to temporary electrical installations.

1.4 DELIVERABLES

The successful service provider shall deliver:

- Four (4) weekly temporary electrical installation inspections per month.
- Four (4) detailed weekly inspection reports per month.
- One (1) monthly compliance summary report.
- Immediate non-conformance notifications for any critical safety issues identified during inspections.

1.5 COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS

Inspections shall be conducted by a competent person with appropriate electrical qualifications and statutory registrations applicable to temporary electrical installations in South Africa.

The proposed inspector(s) should demonstrate:

- Relevant electrical trade qualification and/or technical certification.
- Knowledge of temporary electrical installations on construction sites.
- Experience conducting compliance inspections and audits.
- Knowledge of OHSA, Construction Regulations, Electrical Installation Regulations, and relevant SANS standards.
- Valid registrations or certifications where required by legislation.

1.6 PRICING REQUIREMENTS

The quotation shall clearly indicate:

- Monthly inspection fee.
- Rate for additional inspections (if required).
- Travel and accommodation costs (if applicable).
- Applicable VAT.
- Total contract price.
- Any other fees if applicable

All prices shall remain fixed for the duration of the contract period unless otherwise agreed in writing.
